# SURREY RUN

Well, here we are at the beginning of March following a recent period of rather grim weather. I am sure that Spring is nearly here and we can start thinking about all our MG activities planned for 2020. My main thought is this year's 20th anniversary of our SURREY RUN due to take place on the **12<sup>th</sup> JULY** finishing at **LEONARDSLEE LAKES and GARDENS**, Horsham, West Sussex.

I must say that the credit for this chosen destination has to go to Paul Coleman who having visited Leonardslee last Summer suggested that I go along to check it out. I arranged a meeting last July just a few days after the 2019 Run not realizing that they had only officially been open for just a couple of months. This story is quite interesting. Leonardslee was originally bought in 1888 by a guy called Sir Edmund Loader who created the gardens with a wide range of animals. Remaining in the family, it was then open to the public for many years. Despite over 70,000 visitors in its final year, the owners had financial difficulties and closed in 2010. After years of neglect, the then derelict 200 acre site was purchased in 2017 by Penny Streeter, one of the Dragons from the TV series Dragons Den. It was described, as looking like Jurassic Park but she spent 2 years and millions of pounds beautifully restoring it to its former glory, opening once again in April 2019, just in time for us.

Leonardslee has much to offer its visitors. The gardens are world famous for its flora and fauna. As well as the trees, the gardens contain outstanding examples of rhododendrons, azaleas, camellias, magnolias, bluebells and ornamental rock gardens. Leonardslee is also famous for its wallabies, still roaming free since its closure in 2010. There are also three species of deer in the park.

Penny Streeter has an interest in South African wine estates, and this is reflected in the Pinotage vineyard at Leonardslee containing over 66,000 vines across 16 hectares. Also on display is a building containing the largest dolls house I have seen in my life. This depicts an Edwardian estate and neighbouring villages at 1/12<sup>th</sup> scale. The detail is incredible.

I will say more about these features as time goes on but details and a booking form for the 2020 SURREY RUN can be found on our **EPSOM MGOc WEB SITE** [www.epsommgoc.org.uk](http://www.epsommgoc.org.uk). I have also added a booking form at the end of this article for Club members not yet registered, as I am confident it will be a great day.


