SURREY RUN

SURREY RUN 2020 and the COVID-19 Virus

I would first like to thank those already booked for this event. Part of the Epsom Area remit has always been to raise funds for local deserving causes. I am proud to say that with the fantastic support of the Epsom Membership, we have consistently achieved these goals. Unfortunately, this year is different. Those already registered will have been contacted, but it is with a very heavy heart that I have to inform you all that for this year, **SURREY RUN 2020 WILL NO LONGER TAKE PLACE ON SUNDAY 12 JULY.**

For some while we have been monitoring the COVID-19 CORONAVIRUS situation with a view to taking this decision. Not just our country but the whole world is in uncharted waters where the scientific fraternity are under great pressure, trying to learn about something that has never been experienced before yet are still being asked questions such as "how serious is it really going to be and how long will it last". If only we had a crystal ball and knew the answers. Despite these unknown factors, decisions have to be made. As time has passed, developments with Government guidelines have resulted in the UK going into general lockdown. At Epsom MGOC we have a responsibility towards the health and safety of our participants together with all our own members involved in implementing the day. Although July is still a while ahead, it is very clear to me that regarding the Surrey Run for this year, we have made the correct decision.

So where does this leave us? I have been in contact with Becky Hildry, the director of Bocketts Farm where we start the Run. The Farm has been closed for some time and Becky says it is so strange with just the animals and no people.

The final destination for the SURREY RUN 2020 was to the Leonardslee Lakes and Gardens in Sussex. I have renegotiated the situation with Leonardslee. This has resulted in a straight forward postponement to a new date next year of **Sunday**, **18**th **July 2021**. I have been overwhelmed by the support and response in numbers registered so far for this event and have contacted over 90 participants already booked. Our offer to participants is that by maintaining their confirmed "ENTRY NUMBER", we can preserve the same terms and conditions, should they so wish, for a **simple postponement to the new date of SUNDAY**, **18**th **July 2021**. I am pleased to say that only one entrant has asked for their money back but I have had many replies of encouragement from the others.

Any future advertising will reflect these changes and our website has already been updated with the new information. On a positive note, when this situation has settled we will be all set and in a very good position to pick up the pieces and continue with our charity plans for next year.


