SURREY RUN 2020 and the COVID-19 Virus

Unfortunately, this year is different. Those already registered will have been contacted, but it is with a very heavy heart that I have to inform you all that for this year, **SURREY RUN 2020 WILL NO LONGER TAKE PLACE ON SUNDAY 12 JULY.**

So where does this leave us? I have been in contact with Becky Hildry, the director of Bocketts Farm where we start the Run and the final destination for the SURREY RUN 2020 was to the Leonardslee Lakes and Gardens in Sussex. I have renegotiated the situation with both Bocketts Farm and Leonardslee. This has resulted in a straight forward postponement to a new date next year of **Sunday, 18th July 2021.** I have been overwhelmed by the support and response in numbers registered so far for this event and have contacted over 90 participants already booked. Our offer to participants is that by maintaining their confirmed "ENTRY NUMBER", we can preserve the same terms and conditions, should they so wish, for a **simple postponement to the new date of SUNDAY, 18th July 2021.** I am pleased to say that only one entrant has asked for their money back but I have had many replies of encouragement from the others. **Therefore, we have some 91 cars pre-booked for 2021.**

Any future advertising will reflect these changes, as shown in last month's "Enjoying MG" and our website has already been updated with the new information. On a positive note, when this situation has settled we will be all set and in a very good position to pick up the pieces and continue with our charity plans for next year.


