## **BROWN FAMILY UPDATE**

#### Mark and Jamie Brown's Visit to Gaydon and Longbridge in July 2020:

Members, Mark and Jamie Brown went on a visit to the British Motor Museum in July to look at the MGF Prototype and the MG Land Speed Record Cars. Whilst there, they decided to go across to Longbridge to see the site before further demolition of the site.

An MG Motors Dealership Paul Rigby has opened in the old Conference Centre and by chance, on a slow Sunday afternoon, the manager offered to show them around the "definitely not open to the public"!! MG Museum.

Amongst the variety of cars tucked up around the back in a very "ad-hoc" display were the first MGF off the production line (sporting a technically incorrect number plate MGF1) and the last MGTF off the production line. Other cars included the MG TF GT concept prototype and some other cars, including the five millionth car produced at Longbridge, which was a Rover 75.

Mark and Jamie say they were privileged to see these cars and Mark was even luckier when he sat in MGF1 (See Front Cover).

Finally, thanks to the Management and staff at Paul Rigby MG.

#### Jamie Brown's Midget 1500:

Some, three years ago Jamie (then aged 14) acquired a 1979 Rubber Bumper MG Midget 1500, from Blackpool, with the intention of saving and restoring the car.

Originally, with his Dad's help, the idea was to restore the car and rebuild the engine, which Jamie coaxed into life for the first time in 6 years.

Sadly, the body of the car was too far gone to save and outside the funding the family had available.

However, a chance meeting at Brooklands, with a Guy who had installed a K Series engine into a Midget, turned Jamie in a different direction.

The family have recently managed to acquire a low mileage VVC MGF engine, from a crashed car owned by a friend of theirs. Mark advises me that he and his wife have now lost the use of their garage for some time!

Mark says he is not sure how this will all be funded, or even insured, but we wish Jamie good luck in this enterprise.

On the plus side Jamie recently obtained a Distinction in his first year of his Vehicle Technology (Motorsport) course at Brooklands College. He has passed his Driving Theory Test and is awaiting, like many 17 year olds, a date for his actual test.

He has spent lockdown mostly working and seems to want to spend the money he has saved on A Ford Sierra 5 Speed Gearbox, which can't all be bad.






