# SURREY RUN 2025

Well, we have just a few weeks to go before the major event of our year "SURREY RUN 2025" due to take place on the 13th July. After travelling about 60 miles in the beautiful countryside of Surrey and Sussex all the participants will be greeted at the Gatwick Aviation Museum by our special Epsom Area marshals. Resulting from our active advertising efforts, we have an encouraging flow of cars registering to take part. John Brooke is once again our Routemaster and is busy planning a fresh route for this new venue. Final meetings are still to be arranged with both Bocketts Farm and the Aviation Museum to ensure that all goes well on the day.

I am going to digress to a story that you may find interesting and has some relevance to past members of our Club and Epsom Area Special Events. I must first say that after 25 years we are no longer in possession of our white 1965 Midget that you may have seen at some of our Club Stand events. The car has been sold back to a previous owner, Tim Jones, a friend of many decades and fellow MG enthusiast with a major interest in motor sport using his rally prepared 1967 MG Midget. He lives in Bookham just along the road overlooking Bocketts farm where we start our July event. Back in the 1990s when we ran the Southern National MG event at Leatherhead, we organised technical seminars during the weekend. Tim hosted one of these and with his experience he explained the mysteries and tuning of the SU carburettor. In his other circles he also knew Epsom members, Trevor Taylor and Mike the Pipe, both associated with specialised MG exhaust systems.

Tim had always shown an admiration for our red 1970 Mk3 Midget. During one of his visits he announced that if I was interested, he had a spare early Midget that was at the end of its useful life. It was in a terrible state and had been stored in a



barn for some years. I put my hand in my pocket, found

some loose change and in the year 2000 the deal was done. My surprise was that when I saw the Log-Book I noticed that the car belonged to his wife, Fiona. The very first outing of the car after restoration was at one of our events at Whiteley village in 2017. Tim and Fiona joined us where it proved a very emotional moment for her. Previously, when I cut out the boot floor, I discovered a quantity of confetti, and it turned out that they drove the car through the Italian Alps on their honeymoon. It was then I decided that they should have first refusal if I ever decided to sell the car.

The complete story started in the 1980s when Tim's rally car was virtually written off by a large truck. As it was also his

everyday ride, he needed a car to get him about, so bought the white Midget from an owner in Dorking. When the rally car was back on the road in 1988, Tim gave the much-loved white Midget to his girlfriend, Fiona who eventually became his wife. Recently Tim took up the offer of buying the Midget back from us as a surprise present for Fiona's birthday on Wednesday 14th May. Both our families have always had an interest in the town of Swanage in Dorset where they hope to retire and where the car will live, just a mile away from our MGB. On the 14th, Tim drove the car from Bookham to Swanage joining Fiona who was already staying there for a few days. She sent us a message saying that she was living in a dream, indicated by the photo. I hope they pop along the road to see us at Bocketts Farm in July when they are back at Bookham.
